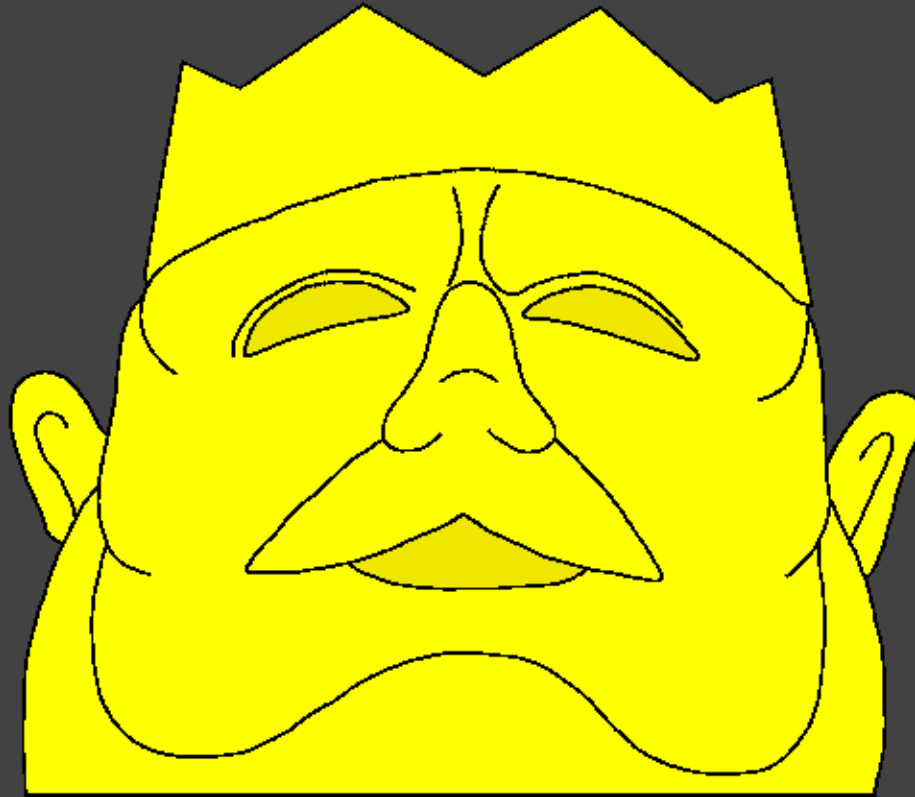

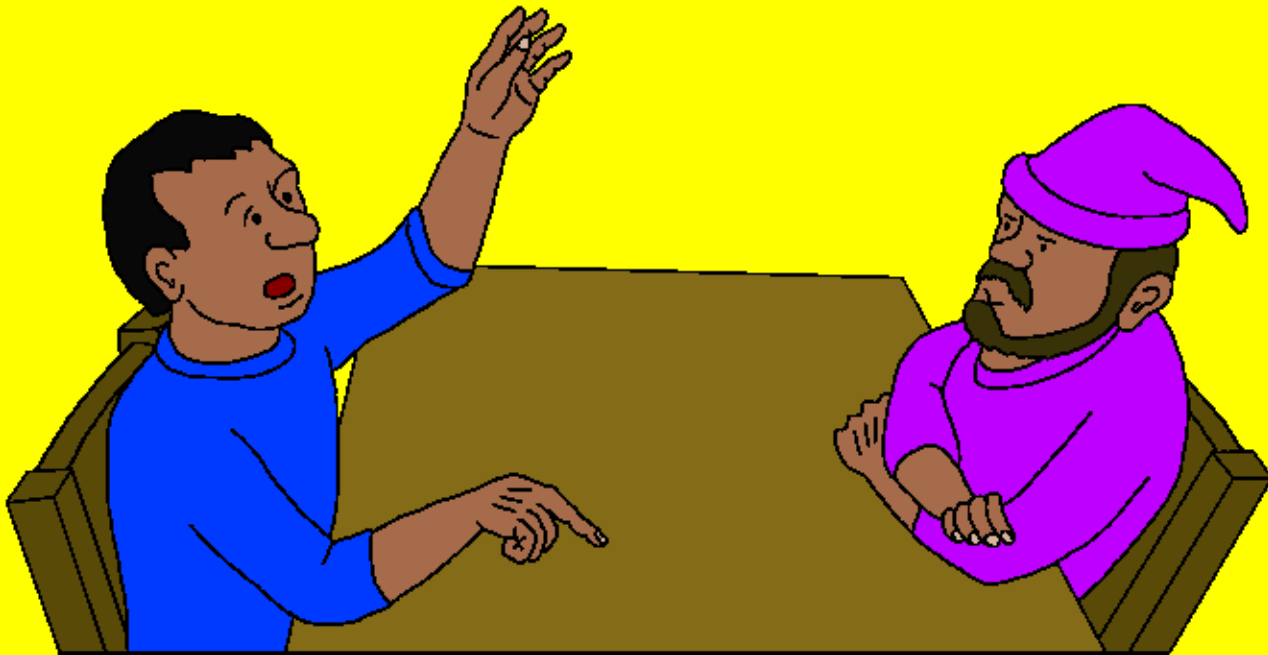

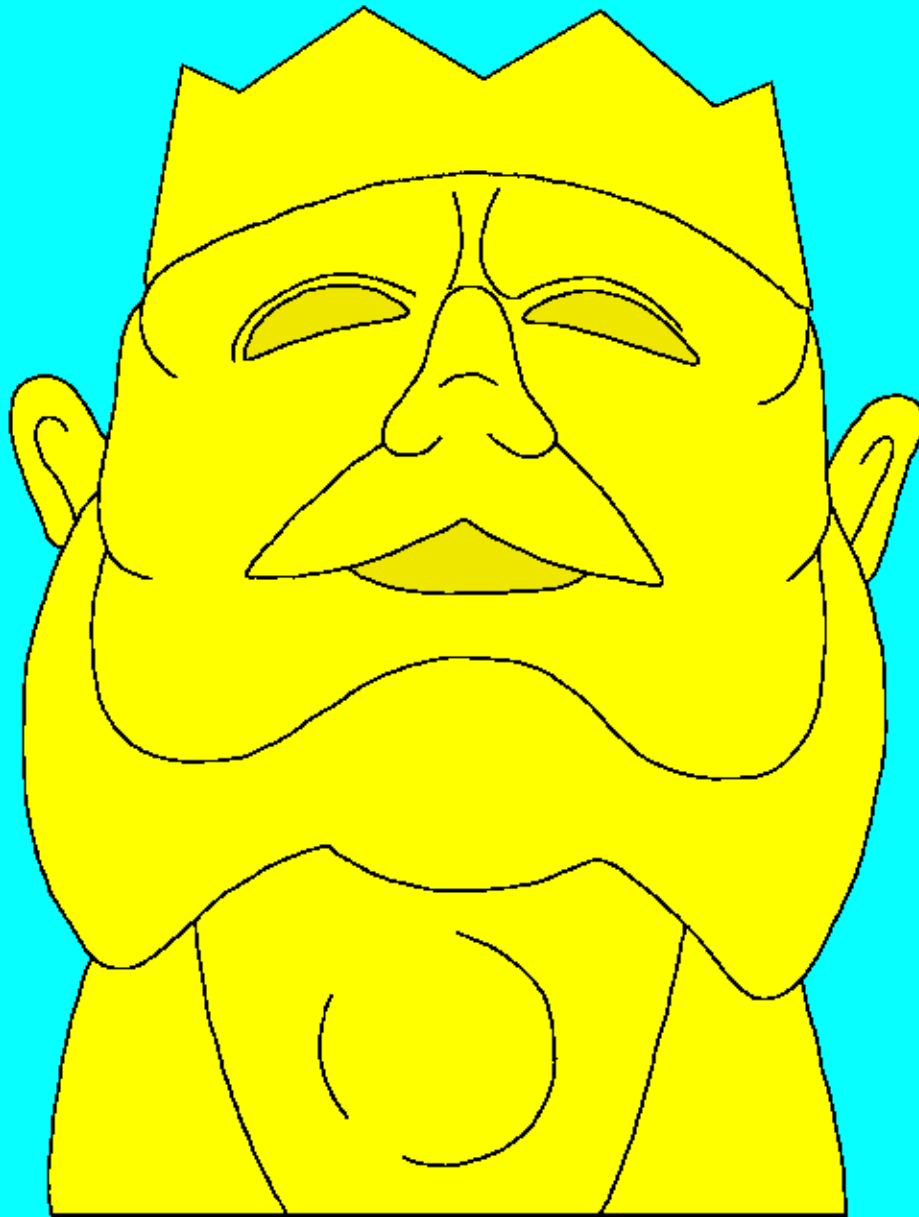
King Nebuchadnezzar had a dream, and this dream troubled him a lot. By God's power, Daniel was able to tell the king the meaning of his dream.



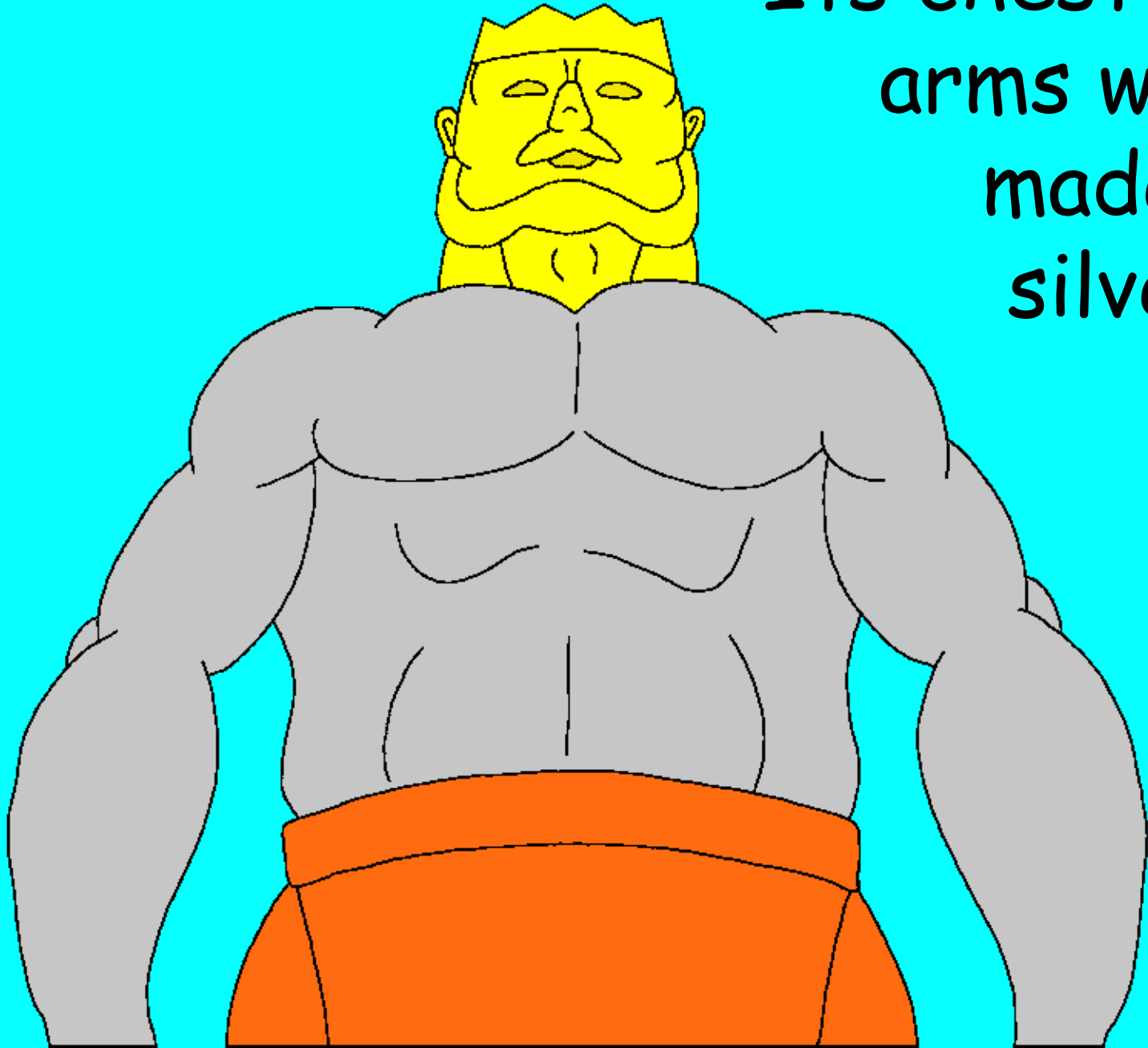
The first thing Daniel did was to describe the dream exactly. "You saw a great image of a huge statue, O King. Its form was awesome!"



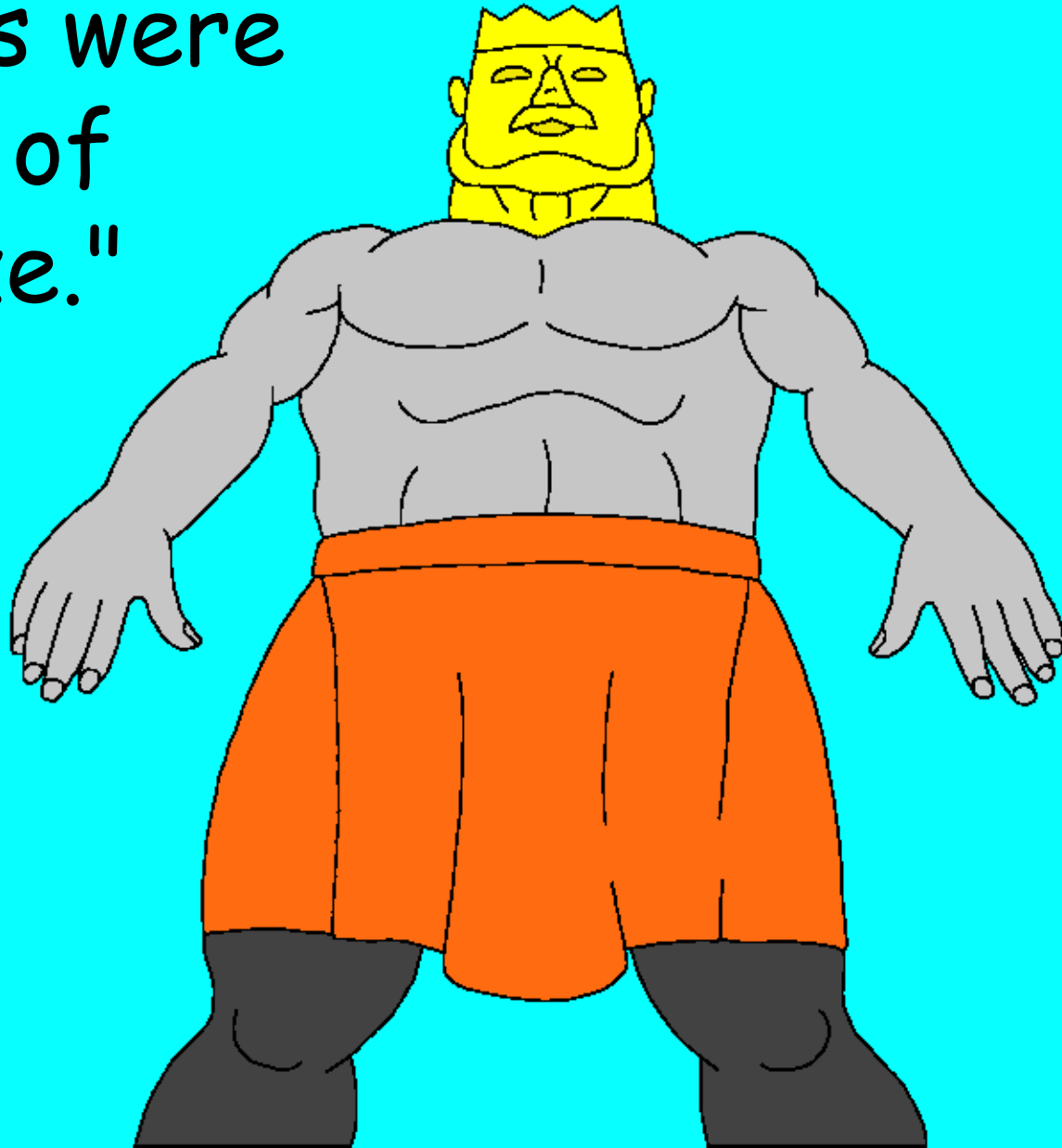
"The statue's head was made

continued.



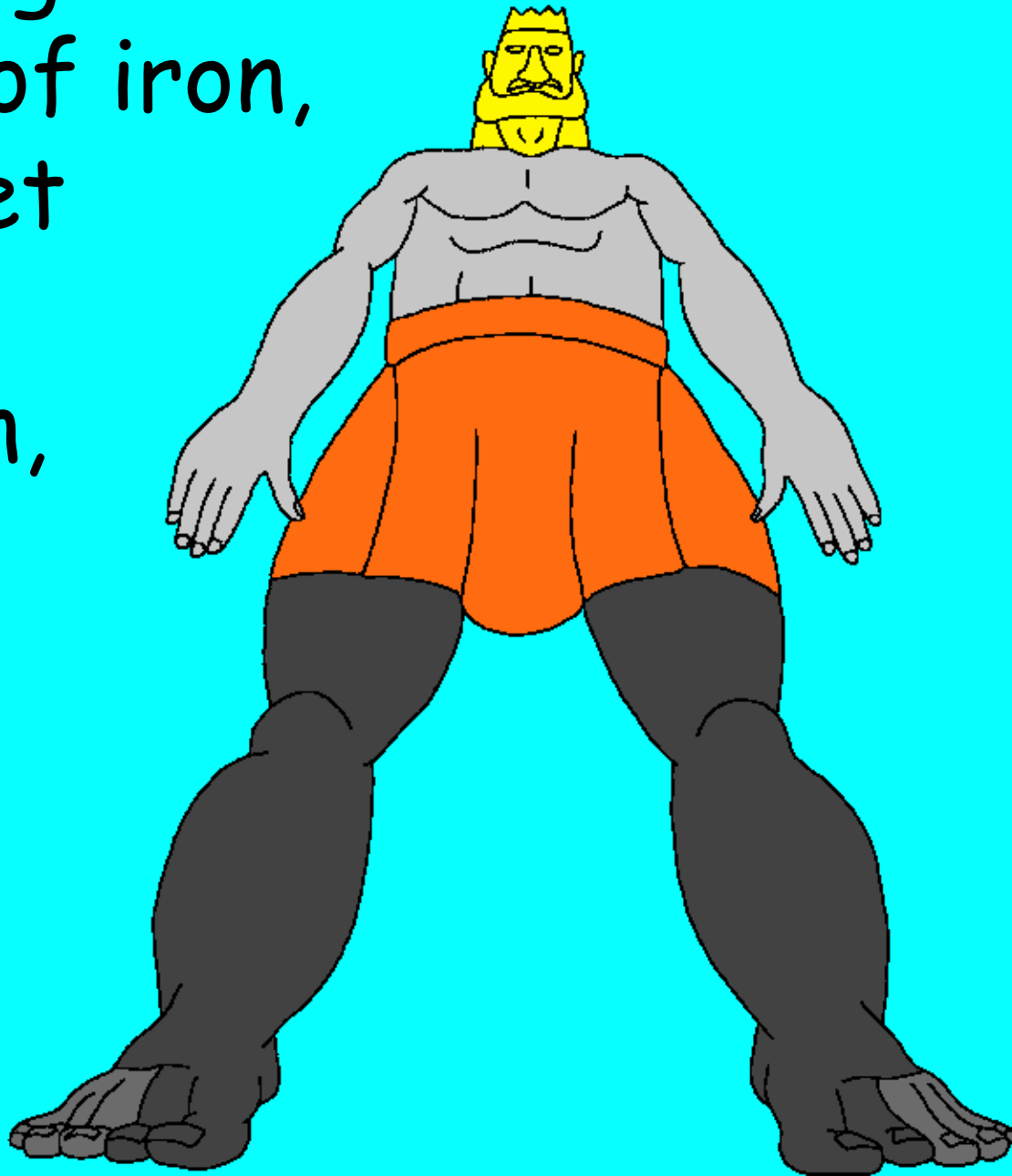
"Its chest and

bronze."



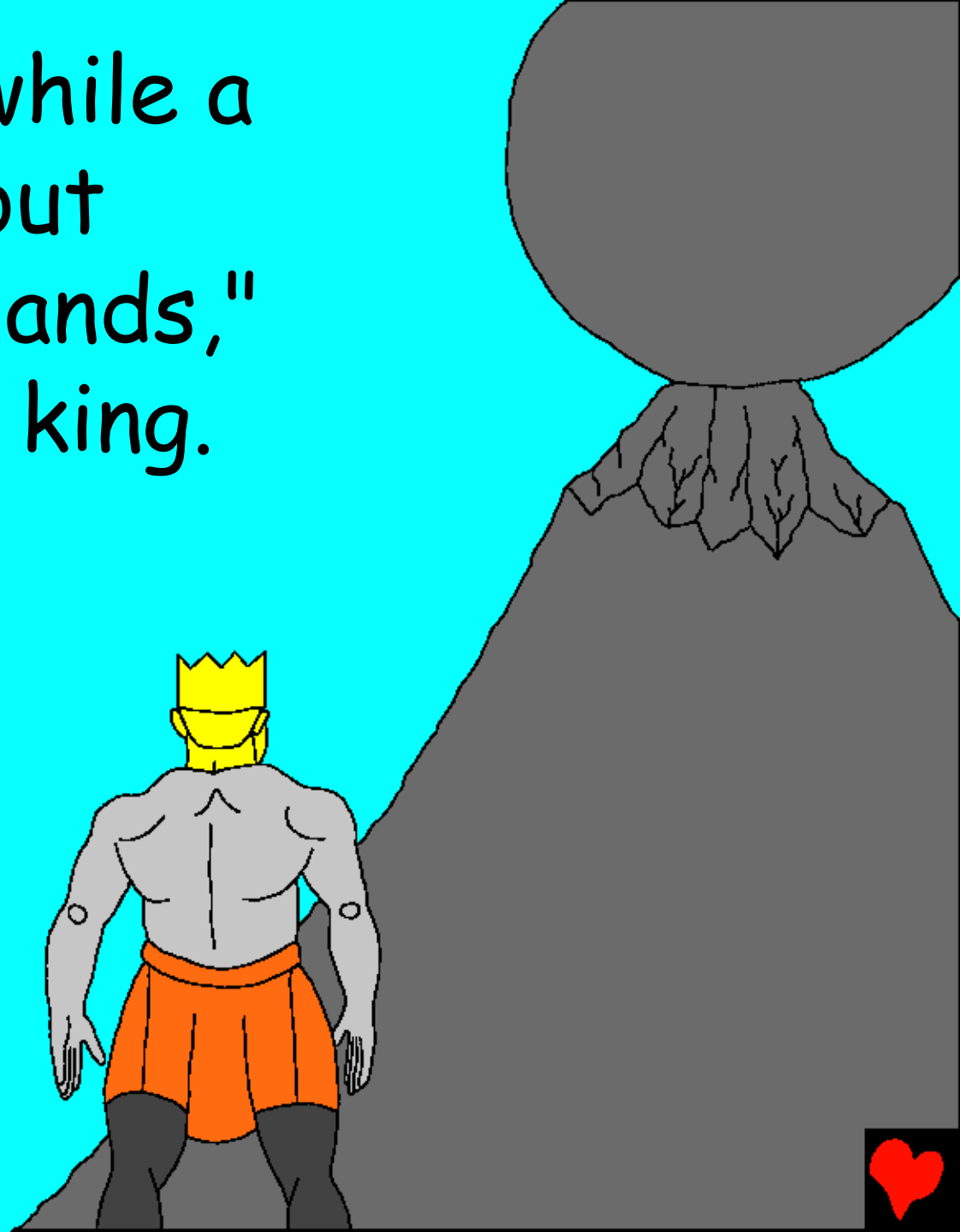
"Its legs were

clay."



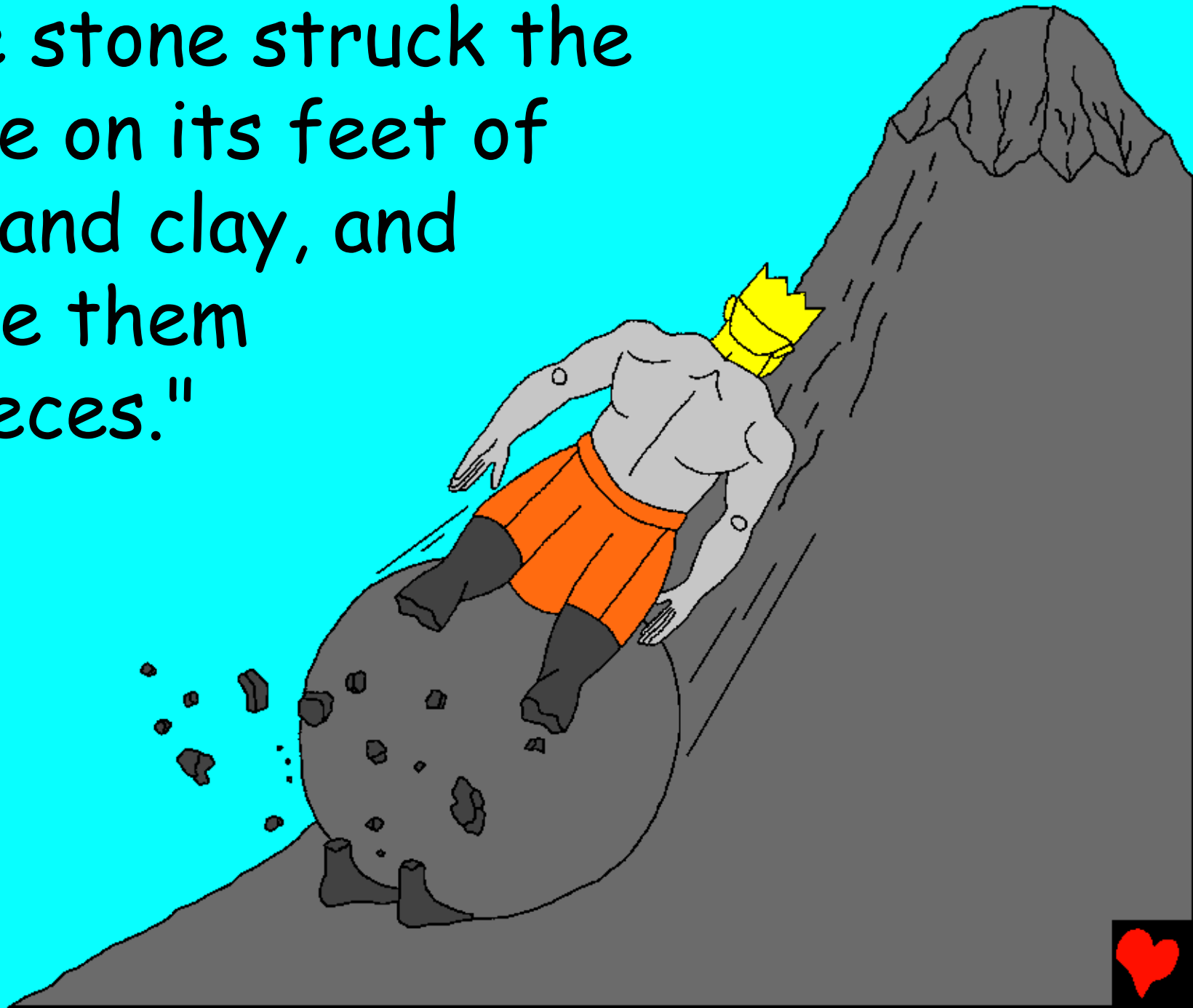
After describing the statue to the king, Daniel told him the rest of the dream.

"The stone struck the image on its feet of iron and clay, and broke them in pieces."



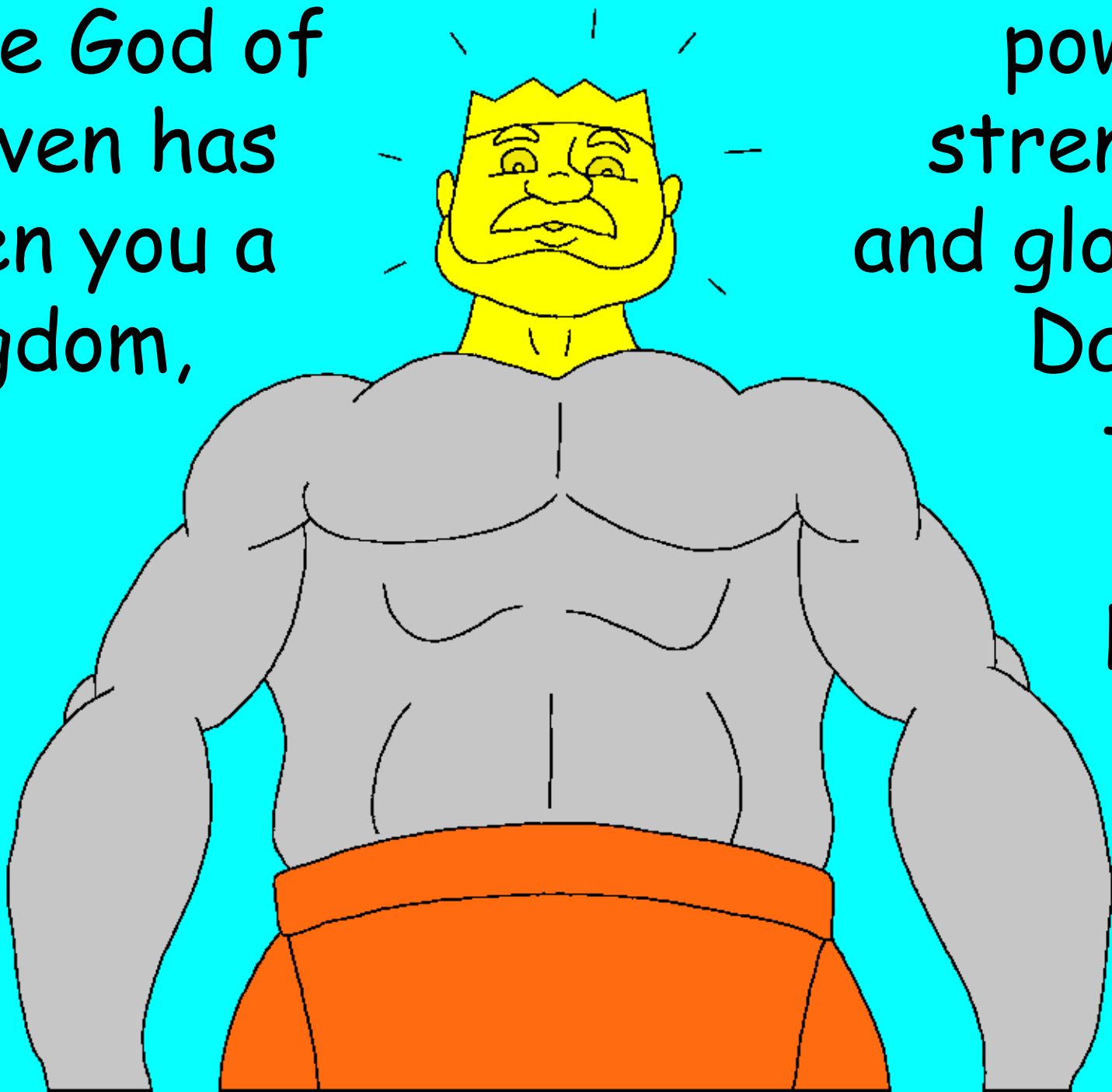
"Then the statue was crushed into dust and blown away." Daniel paused. "And the stone grew into a huge mountain that filled the earth."
